

### Literacy:

We will be beginning our Under The Sea topic by writing some letters and postcards that develop our skills in descriptive writing. We will also be learning lots of facts about creatures under the sea for some factual writing.

This half term we will also be developing our reading comprehension skills and building on our understanding and application of grammar.

### Science:

Following on from last term, we will continue to explore water by doing more experiments involving water. The children have also had discussions in their own time about where water comes from, so we will be learning about the water cycle and answering some of their own questions.

### Design and Technology:


We will be designing and making some stained glass windows.
